2015/907 **Planning** – It was resolved to submit the following responses to MSDC for application
 nos. 0377/16 Change of use of agricultural land to increase the size of the residential
 garden at East House, High Road – *"Great Finborough Parish Council have NO*
 OBJECTION to this application based on the information available" and
2015/908 Application no. 0373/16 Erection of single storey rear extension (following demolition of
 existing conservatory) Installation of 3 no. dormer windows to front and 1 no. dormer
 window to rear. Extensions to roof to form gables ends (hip to gable conversion) Render
 finish applied to existing external walls and installation of roof lights to rear roof
 elevations
 "Great Finborough Parish Council have NO OBJECTION to this application based on the
 information available however would like to express their concerns that the loss of the
 garage/parking on site will possibly increase the problems of overflow parking on the
 village green."

 It was agreed that an initial consultation questionnaire be drafted for the newsletter,
 school and pub to establish how the community would like to progress any improvement
